CONSENT FORM – JUNTOS PROGRAM EVALUATION

1. WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THIS FORM?

This form contains information you will need to help you decide whether to be in this program evaluation or not. Please read the form carefully and ask the Juntos coordinator questions about anything that is not clear.

2. WHY IS THIS RESEARCH STUDY BEING DONE?

The purpose of this program evaluation is to understand how this program affects the perspectives, knowledge, and skills of all participants and to determine which aspects of the program are most effective for students and their parents in Oregon. These results will help the JUNTOS program to grow and support future students and their parents. Results will also be included in research presentations and publications. Juntos program staff are co-investigators on this research and will see the data collected.

3. WHY AM I BEING INVITED TO TAKE PART IN THIS STUDY?

You are being invited to take part in this evaluation because you and your daughter/son have volunteered to participate in the Juntos trainings to learn more about academic success.

4. WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF I TAKE PART IN THIS RESEARCH STUDY?

If you choose to take part in this study you will fill out a pre-training and demographic survey at the first of six two-hour Juntos trainings that you will return to the regional coordinator. On week 6 you will be asked to fill out a post-survey. We will ask if you and your child want to participate in group conversations (also called focus groups).

We are also asking your permission to have your child participate in the research. We will ask your child to answer survey questions three times about school, their experiences in Juntos, and their relationship with you. We will not ask them to use class time to do this. Also, we request your permission to obtain GPA and attendance records of your child, at the beginning and at the end of each academic year in which you and your child participate in Juntos.

Finally, we ask your permission now for us to use the survey data in future studies, without being contacted about each future study. Future use of your information will be limited to studies about how students are impacted by Juntos. You can retract your consent at any time and we will destroy all materials. However, at the end of the study, we will destroy identifying information and you will no longer be able to remove your information.

If you feel uncomfortable you can choose to not respond. If you feel uncomfortable and would like to talk to someone, you are encouraged to talk with a school counselor.

The benefits of this study are to learn more about the benefits of Juntos and how we can continue to offer and improve the program

7. WILL I BE PAID FOR BEING IN THIS STUDY?

You will not be paid for being in this program.

8. WILL IT COST ME ANYTHING TO BE IN THIS STUDY?

We only ask for you to contribute your time by participating in the trainings and survey. We will provide you with free childcare during the trainings.

10. WHO WILL SEE THE INFORMATION I GIVE?

There is a chance that we could accidentally disclose information that identifies you. Only the study team will know your identification numbers that are placed on the survey. All identifying information will be kept in a locked file cabinet. Federal regulatory agencies and the Oregon State University Institutional Review Board (a committee that reviews and approves research studies) may inspect and copy records pertaining to this research. Some of these records could contain information that personally identifies you. If the results of this project are published your identity will not be made public. The report of program and evaluation results aggregated at the state level will be provided to the funding source and participating school districts.

11. WHAT OTHER CHOICES DO I HAVE IF I DO NOT TAKE PART IN THIS STUDY?

Participation in this study is voluntary. If you decide to participate you are free to withdraw at any time without penalty. If you choose to withdraw from this project before it ends, the researchers may keep information collected about you and this information may be included in study reports. If you choose not to participate in this study you can still participate in Juntos.
